

Dine Out Indy: Downtown Street Closures

The Indianapolis Department of Public Works will partially close roadways on May 22 to create four pedestrian-friendly corridors in the downtown area. This will allow for proper social distancing in these areas, as well as additional opportunities for outdoor dining and retail set-up. The road closure locations will include sections of Massachusetts Avenue and Georgia Street.

Closures are expected to last through July 4 weekend in conjunction with the city's Safe Summer reopening plan and Marion County Public Health Department orders.

MASSACHUSETTS AVENUE WILL BE CLOSED FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH COLLEGE AVENUE TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH NEW YORK AND DELAWARE STREETS

Northeast-bound traffic on Massachusetts Avenue will detour eastbound on New York Street, then northbound on College Avenue before rejoining the route.

Southwest-bound traffic on Massachusetts Avenue will detour westbound on St. Clair Street, then southwest on Ft. Wayne Avenue, then southbound on Pennsylvania Street, then eastbound on New York Street before rejoining the route.
