

PLEASANT RUN GREENWAYS TRAIL ENHANCEMENTS



PROJECT DETAILS

The Pleasant Run Trail enhancement project focuses on connecting three locations along the trail to provide an updated, safe, ADA-accessible pathway that will connect the existing trail segments.

Location #1 – A 10' wide asphalt trail will be provided along the Washington Street, from E Pleasant Run Pkwy N Dr. to Emerson Ave, which will proceed north along the east side of Emerson Ave to E Pleasant Run Pkwy S Dr. and will continue to proceed along the north side of E Pleasant Run Pkwy S Dr. to the existing pedestrian bridge north of Butler Ave. A modification to the Washington Street bridge over Pleasant Run creek, and a reduction in pavement width along a portion of E Pleasant Run Pkwy S Dr. are currently a part of the enhancement plans.

Location #2 – A wider prefabricated bridge will replace the existing footbridge located south of Brookville Rd along the existing Pleasant Run Greenway. A 10' wide multi-use path will be provided along the north side of Pleasant Run Pkwy W Dr. north to Brookville Rd where it will cross on the west side of Brookville/Pleasant Run intersection and tie into existing trail.

Location #3 – A 10' wide asphalt trail will be provided along the south/east side of E Pleasant Run Pkwy N Dr. from Southeastern to English Ave where it will continue along the south side of English to east side of LaSalle St where it will cross and continue along the north side of English from LaSalle to E Pleasant Run Pkwy N Dr. A raised concrete median will be provided at the Pleasant Run/English intersection to better delineate vehicular traffic and provide a safe east-west crossing for pedestrian across Pleasant Run. English Ave will be reduced to 1 westbound lane from LaSalle to Sherman.

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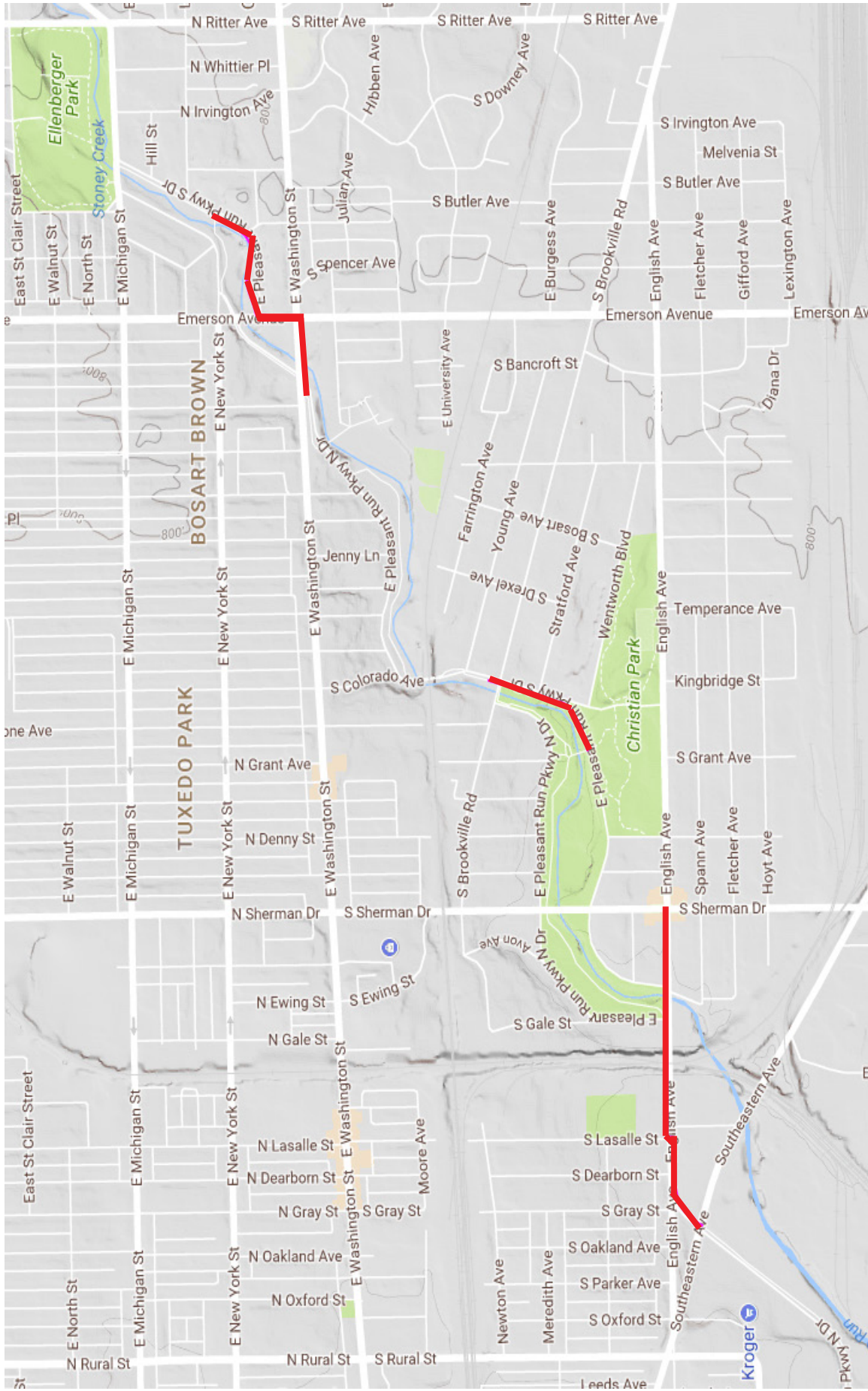
